



PEST PREPARATION GUIDE · GERMAN COCKROACH

Cockroach Spray Treatment

German cockroaches hide in kitchens, bathrooms, cracks, cabinets and warm appliance areas. Good preparation lets your Terra13 technician treat active hiding spots safely and effectively.

- Spray treatment
- Re-entry ~4–6 hrs
- No-wash 14–21 days

BEFORE YOUR TREATMENT

Tick each box as you prepare

1 Kitchen preparation

- Empty cabinets, drawers, countertops and under-sink
- Bag or seal food, dishes and utensils
- Clean grease, crumbs and spills (counters, floors, stove)
- Empty bins and take garbage out

2 Appliances

- Pull appliances away from the wall if you can
- Includes fridge, stove, dishwasher and microwave stand
- Roaches love the warmth behind them

3 Bathroom preparation

- Clear hygiene products from cabinets
- Empty under-sink storage areas
- Wipe up moisture and standing water

4 General cleaning

- Vacuum floors thoroughly before treatment
- Reduce clutter throughout the home
- Remove cardboard boxes if possible
- No pet food or water out overnight

Re-entry time — wait about 4–6 hours

Stay out of treated areas for roughly 4–6 hours after the spray (or as your technician advises) before returning — especially with children and pets.

AFTER YOUR TREATMENT

What to expect

- You may see more roach activity for a few days
- Dead or dying roaches may appear in the open
- This is normal — it means the treatment is working

Aftercare

- Don't wash treated areas for 14–21 days
- No bleach or strong cleaners on treated surfaces
- Don't spray store-bought insecticides afterward

Keep it up — for best results
